

SQC MEMBERSHIP RULES - AMENDMENTS TO RULES

You will be given notice of the specific changes made to the Standards and the date that they will come into effect. When changes are made to the Membership Rules, SQC will give You notice of the changes, when the new or amended Rules come into effect and where You can view and/or download copies of the amended Rules. You must ensure full compliance with all such changes to the Standards and the Membership Rules in order to retain SQC Assured status.'
